"FROM HEAVEN, OR OF MEN?"

Please examine the following statements for their truthfulness. Print this document and then circle True or False to mark your answers.

(T) OR (F) 1. In Genesis 6:14, we learn that God commanded Noah to build an ark out of gopher wood.

(T) OR (F) 2. God did not specifically condemn the use of other kinds of woods, but he did specify gopher wood and that excluded all other kinds of woods.

(T) OR (F) 3. Had Noah used another kind of wood than that which God specified, then he would have disobeyed God.

(T) OR (F) 4. In Exodus 12:5, God commanded the children of Israel to offer a lamb for sacrifice.

(T) OR (F) 5. God did not specifically condemn the use of another kind of animal for this offering, but he did specify a lamb; and that excluded all other kinds of animals.

(T) OR (F) 6. Had the Israelites used another kind of animal than what God had specified, then they would have disobeyed God.

(T) OR (F) 7. In Ephesians 5:19, Colossians 3:16 and Hebrews 2:12 etc., we find that God has commanded Christians to make vocal music (sing).

(T) OR (F) 8. God did not specifically condemn the use of another kind of music, but he did specify (Vocal Music) and that excluded all other kinds of music.

(T) OR (F) 9. It would be an act of disobedience to have used oak when God had specified gopher wood; to have offered a pig, when God had specified a lamb, therefore, it is an act of disobedience to use vocal music! (singing)
